

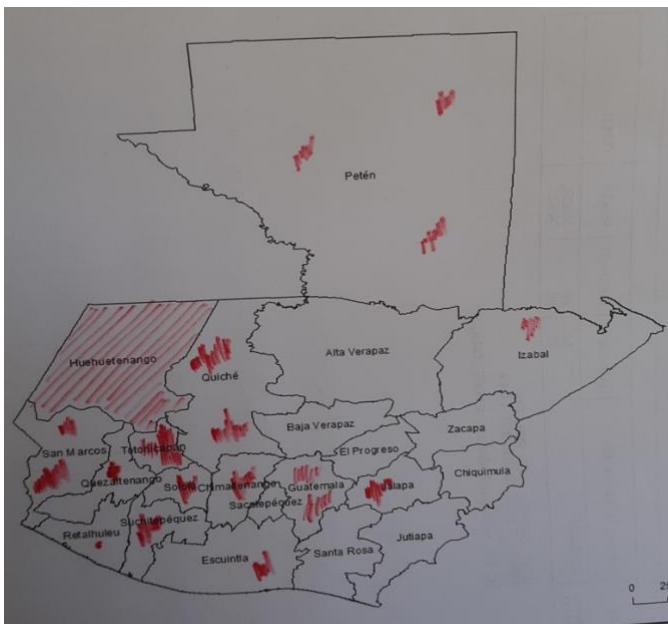
Action Bible Distribution Report

Greetings from Guatemala! We praise the Lord for what He is doing around the country through the Action Bible Program. It is my pleasure to give you the following update.

Distribution:

We continue reaching into the public schools at El Quiche 6%, Totonicapan 40%, San Marcos 6%, Chimaltenango 4%, Suchitepequez 2%, Escuintla 4%, Jutiapa 2%, Guatemala 20%, Quetzaltenango 3%, Solola 15%, Izabal 3% and El Peten 13%.

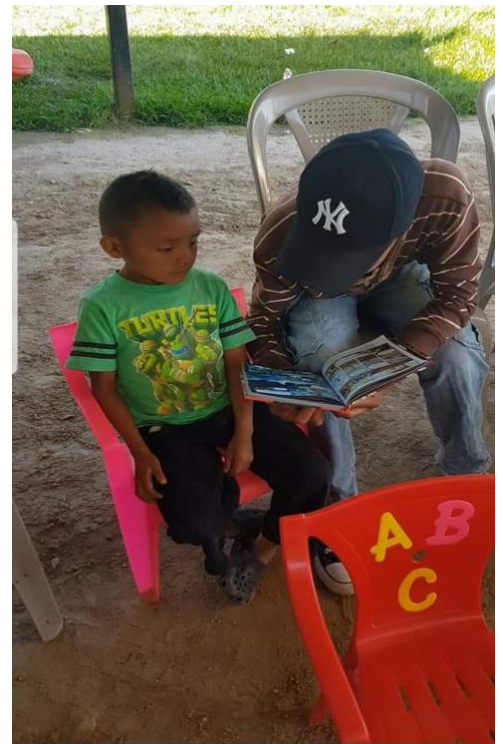
We are working in police institutions in San Marcos, Quetzaltenango and el Quiche and the church is growing inside.
