Use this list of collectible items to involve your church and friends in your trip.

### Medicines:

Over the counter medicines are needed for the clinic at Paradise Bound. Please ask Maureen for an updated list of medications that are needed prior to collecting items.

### Collecting Relationship Building Items

Collecting items to be used either at the home building sites, VBS, or during the medical clinic/outreaches is a wonderful way to involve your family, friends, and/or church. Keep in mind that these items are a **tool to build relationships with, not a toy giveaway**.

Your choices are endless, but here are some ideas:

- Stickers
- Crayons and coloring books (with minimal English words in them)
- Footballs, soccer balls, nerf balls (deflated), we have pumps and needles to inflate them in Guatemala
- Beach balls, Frisbees, jump ropes, etc.
- Bright nail polish
- Craft items that DO NOT use glue and are simple to do
- Hair items (combs, brushes, headbands, hair ties, etc....)
- Sidewalk Chalk
- Facepaint
